Isabella E. Alderson - better known as Bella Alderson. (Gibson Memorial Library's first Librarian from 1931 - 1942)

According to the 1940 Census, Bella listed her occupation as, "Librarian" and industry as, "City Library" and her income as "\$900". She lived at 705 W. Mills Street in Creston, IA. Her highest grade of schooling listed was "high school, 4th year."

Prior to being the Library Director, the 1910 and 1920 Census reveals that Bella was a "teacher" at the "public schools".



